


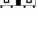

-  **Apartments (including Condominiums)**
Apartment means one or more rooms with private bath and kitchen facilities comprising an independent self contained dwelling unit grouped together with one or more dwelling units on a single lot, parcel, or tract. A dwelling unit used exclusively for lease or rent as a residence in which an owner may reside. Not an accessory dwelling unit or a guest dwelling. Condominium means a residential... [Read more](#)
-  **Single-Family Dwelling Unit**
Dwelling, one dwelling unit means a building designed for and occupied exclusively for residential occupancy and having customary kitchen facilities necessary for a single housekeeping unit
-  **Duplex**
Dwelling, two-family or duplex means a building or buildings designed for two families occupying separate, attached, or detached living units. Condominium means a residential, professional, commercial, office, or industrial development, in which each unit is owned individually, whether the unit includes the ground beneath, air space, walls, floors, or any combination thereof, and in which ot...
